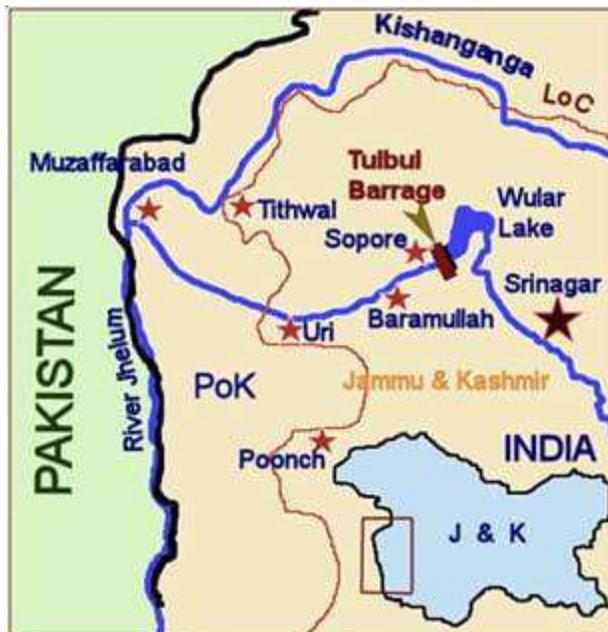
Tulbul Navigation Barrage Project

Syllabus: Prelims Bits – Mapping.

Context:

- The **Jammu & Kashmir government** is considering revival of the project amid discussions around the status of the **Indus Waters Treaty (IWT)**.
- Parallel proposals include diverting additional water resources toward the Jammu region to enhance irrigation, navigation, and hydropower stability.

About Tulbul Navigation Barrage Project



- **Location:** Outlet of **Wular Lake** on the **Jhelum River**, Bandipora district, J&K.
- **Nature:** Navigation lock-cum-control barrage.
- **Objective:**
 - Maintain navigable water depth in the Jhelum during lean winter months (Oct–Feb).
 - Improve water regulation from Wular Lake.
- **Timeline & Dispute**
 - Construction began **1984**.
 - Work halted after objections from Pakistan under the IWT, citing potential violation of storage provisions.
- **Technical Features**

- Length: **439 ft** | Width: **40 ft**.
- Storage capacity: **0.30 million acre-feet (MAF)**.
- Designed to maintain **minimum draft of ~4.4 ft** in Jhelum.
- **Expected Benefits**
 - Year-round navigation over **~20 km stretch (Baramulla–Sopore)**.
 - Flow regulation and flood moderation.
 - Improved firm power generation for downstream projects such as **Uri-I and Uri-II hydropower plants**.

Key Facts about Wular Lake

- **Type:** Largest freshwater lake in India; among the largest in Asia.
- **Location:** Bandipora district, Jammu & Kashmir.
- **Hydrology:** Fed primarily by the **Jhelum River**.
- **Altitude:** ~1,580 m; situated at foothills of **Haramukh Mountain**.
- **Geomorphology:** Tectonic origin basin.
- **Extent:** ~200 sq km (seasonally variable).
- **Ecological status:** Designated **Ramsar Wetland (1990)**.

SAHI and BODH initiative

Syllabus: GS-2: Social Justice – Health.

Context:

- Union Minister of Health & Family Welfare to launch **SAHI** and **BODH** initiatives at the **India AI Summit** held at **Bharat Mandapam**.

SAHI (Strategy for Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare for India)

- **Nature:** National guidance framework for AI adoption in healthcare.
- **Objective:** Ensure **safe, ethical, evidence-based and inclusive** use of AI in India's health system.
- **Key focus areas**
 - Governance and regulatory oversight
 - Data stewardship and interoperability

- Clinical validation and monitoring of AI tools
- Deployment aligned with **public health priorities**
- **Role:** Supports States and institutions in responsible AI implementation.



BODH (Benchmarking Open Data Platform for Health AI)

- **Developed by:** IIT Kanpur + National Health Authority.
- **Nature:** Privacy-preserving benchmarking platform for evaluation of health AI models.
- **Core feature:** Enables testing of AI models on **diverse real-world datasets without sharing raw data** (federated/secure evaluation approach).
- **Status:** Digital Public Good under Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission.

Significance

- Enhances **trust, transparency and quality assurance** in Health AI.
- Facilitates innovation while ensuring **data privacy and ethical safeguards**.
- Strengthens India's digital health ecosystem and AI governance architecture.
- Supports standardisation and interoperability across healthcare institutions.

Loggerhead Turtle

Syllabus: Prelims Bits – Species in news.

Context:

- Rising **ocean temperatures** and **decline in prey availability** are altering the **reproductive cycles, migration routes, and body size** of Loggerhead turtles.
- Warmer sands can skew **sex ratios** (temperature-dependent sex determination), while warming oceans affect **foraging grounds and growth rates**.

About Loggerhead Turtle

- Belongs to **family Cheloniidae** (hard-shelled sea turtles).
- Named for its **large head** with powerful crushing jaws.
- **Largest hard-shelled turtle**; second largest living turtle after the Leatherback sea turtle.



Navigation

- Uses **geomagnetic imprinting** to navigate long migratory routes and return to natal beaches.

Habitat

- Occurs in **open ocean** as well as **coastal habitats** — bays, lagoons, salt marshes and estuaries.

Distribution

- Found across **Atlantic, Indian and Pacific Oceans**, and the **Mediterranean Sea**.

Diet

- **Omnivorous**, primarily feeds on **benthic invertebrates** — gastropods, bivalves and crustaceans.

Lifespan

- Can live **80+ years** with late sexual maturity.

Conservation Status

- **IUCN**: Vulnerable.

Major Threats

- Climate change (temperature rise, sea-level rise)
- Loss of nesting beaches and coastal development
- Egg harvesting and direct exploitation
- Marine pollution and plastic ingestion
- Bycatch in trawls, longlines and gillnets

Food Safety and Standards Authority of India

Syllabus: GS-2: Indian Polity - Statutory Body

Context:

- The Supreme Court of India asked the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) to examine **front-of-pack warning labels** for foods high in sugar, salt and unhealthy fats.

Background:

- Direction arose from a **PIL citing rising lifestyle diseases** such as diabetes, obesity and heart ailments.
- FSSAI stated it is conducting **scientific studies, stakeholder consultations and consumer feedback analysis** before finalising norms.
- Issue highlights judicial focus on **nutrition transparency, preventive public health and consumer welfare**.

Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) — Brief Notes

- **Statutory body**: Established under the **Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006**.
- **Nodal ministry**: Works under the **Ministry of Health & Family Welfare**.
- **Mandate**:

- Regulates and supervises **food safety, standards, manufacture, storage, distribution, sale and import** of food.
- Frames **science-based food standards** to protect public health.
- **Key functions:**
 - Licensing and registration of food businesses.
 - Food quality surveillance, inspections and enforcement.
 - Risk assessment, labelling regulations and consumer awareness campaigns (e.g., *Eat Right India*).
- **Structure:** Headed by a **Chairperson** with a governing body including representatives from government, industry, consumers and experts.
- **Headquarters:** New Delhi.

India-South Korea Relations

Syllabus: GS-2: International Relation – Bilateral Relations – Strategic.

Context:

- India and **South Korea** reaffirmed commitment to deepen the **Special Strategic Partnership** during the **6th Foreign Policy and Security Dialogue (FPSD)** held in **Seoul**.
- Indicates sustained diplomatic momentum ahead of **2026 high-level engagements**.

High-Level Dialogue

- Co-chaired by:
 - **P. Kumaran** — Secretary (East), Ministry of External Affairs (India)
 - **Park Yoon-joo** — First Vice Foreign Minister (Republic of Korea)
- Covered cooperation in:
 - Defence & security
 - Science & technology
 - Culture and people-to-people ties
- Agreement to conduct **high-level visits and Joint Commission meetings in 2026**.

Economic & Technological Cooperation

- Opportunities for Korean investment in:

- **Shipbuilding**
- Maritime infrastructure
- Focus areas:
 - Economic security and resilient supply chains
 - Industrial competitiveness
 - **Critical minerals collaboration**
- Priority emerging technologies:
 - Artificial Intelligence
 - Semiconductors
 - **Green hydrogen**
- Expected outcomes:
 - Innovation boost
 - Clean energy transition
 - Long-term industrial growth
